Dear Parents and Carers,

I want to thank all parents and carers for your support in our transition from the summer holidays into the autumn term.

This has allowed us to focus on the children's mental and emotional health, with staffing at a one to one level throughout the school.

With all pupils now in school full time, I would also like this opportunity to reassure you that we are doing everything we can to keep all pupils and staff safe. We recognise that we can reduce risk, however in a SEN provision as stated in earlier communications, we cannot be totally isolated within our bubbles.

It is with this in mind that I must emphasise to parents and carers to not send their child into school with either a **temperature** or the increasing number of **pupils with diarrhoea**. If we have a continued increase in absence for staff throughout the school, we will have to either close for a deep clean as stated in PHE regulations, close that class 'bubble' for 48 hours or risk infections spreading to other vulnerable children who may be on the same transport.
