Background

The Eagle Appeal Fund mission statement is as follows:-

“The Eagle Appeal Fund is managed and supported by volunteers who aim to fund projects at Rachel Madocks School that will stimulate and enrich the learning experiences of young people with learning disabilities.”

The learners at Rachel Madocks School consist of children aged 2-19 years with complex severe, profound and multiple learning difficulties.

Objects of the Eagle Appeal Fund

The objects of the charity as stated in its constitution are to advance the education of and relieve the charitable needs of children and young people who have sensory and physical impairment by the provision of specialised educational and recreational facilities and equipment including sensory suites, therapy rooms and outdoor play equipment.

The aim of the major fundraising activities for the Eagle Appeal Fund is to raise monies to fund projects for the pupils of Rachel Madocks School.
