

Pupil Achievement Headlines - July 2018 (July 2017)

All our pupils in Key Stages 2, 3 & 4 are making expected progress in both English and Maths with 80% of them making above expected progress and a staggering 17% *exceeding* above expected progress.

- 100% (99%) of pupils are making at least expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 80% (80%) of pupils are making above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 17% (9%) of pupils are *exceeding* above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.

Gender Spilt

- 100% (98%) of boys and 100% (100%) of girls are making at least expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 78% (78%) of boys and 70% (73%) of girls are making above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 23% (4%) of boys and 10% (14%) of girls are *exceeding* above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.

PPG & Non PPG

- 100% (100%) of pupil premium pupils and 100% (94%) of non-pupil premium pupils are making at least expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 91% (79%) of pupil premium pupils and 72% (78%) of non-pupil premium pupils are making above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 15% (8%) of pupil premium pupils and 19% (10%) of non-pupil premium pupils are *exceeding* above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.

SLD & PMLD

- 100% (99%) of SLD pupils and 100% (100%) of PMLD pupils are making at least expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 96% (84%) of SLD pupils and 61% (68%) of PMLD pupils are making above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 26% (11%) of SLD pupils and 5% (5%) of PMLD are *exceeding* above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.

CLA

- 100% (100%) of CLA pupils are making at least expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 80% (100%) are making above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 10% (28%) are *exceeding* above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths

ASC

- 100% (%) of ASC pupils are making at least expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 97% (%) are making above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 40% (%) are *exceeding* above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths

EAL & Ethnicity

Both EAL pupils are making above expected progress in their English and Maths and the same is true for our 3 ethnic pupils.

IBP

- 100% (100%) of pupils on Independent Behaviour Plans are making at least expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 91% (81%) are making above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.
- 28% (3%) are *exceeding* above expected progress in their Key Stage for English and Maths.

It is a tribute to our amazing teachers in school who manage the behaviour of their pupils so well that those on IBPs have done exceptionally well this year in exceeding above expected progress in English & Maths.

7 of the 8 pupils in KS1 are on IBPs with an additional EY pupil also having a behaviour plan and in P16, there are 8 students currently on IBPs, but as they are assessed in different ways they have not been included under this section.
