Your child is now due their Teenage Booster Immunisation as part of the childhood vaccination programme.

This code must be manually typed in exactly as above. When you have submitted your form, you will receive a confirmation email. This may go into your "junk" folder. If you do not receive the email, contact the school who can verify whether it has been submitted.

Due to the pandemic impacting on the childhood vaccination programme, we are not able to confirm a date for the vaccinations. We would ask that you complete the consent form as soon as possible, as the Immunisation Team will be offering the vaccinations at some point during the spring term. Your school will be able to provide you with the date of the session once this has been confirmed.
